

## Number of outbreaks per year

Data on the number of outbreaks per year since 2010 were collected from the Danish Cattle Database. It also contains information of all establishments placed under official restrictions for suspicion and infection with BVDV. The number of outbreaks per year since 2010 is shown in Table 3. The year of confirmation of the outbreak is noted, i.e. not the assumed introduction of the infection in the herd.

Only establishments, where spread of virus has taken place, are included. Establishments to which antibody positive animals have been moved are not included, irrespective of ownership and official restrictions. If a farmer owns several establishments, and it could be stated that infection and spread of virus only has occurred on one of the establishments, this will only account for one outbreak. However, all his farms would be placed under official restrictions and included in the statistics as a farm infected with BVD (Table 1).
