After some years of recession, Danish agriculture is on its way up, says the Jyllands-Posten daily newspaper.

According to an analysis carried out by the Knowledge Centre for Agriculture, the majority of Danish farmers expect increases in profits, production and investments over the next year, and every third farmer on the largest farms plans to increase investments by more than 25 percent.

The analysis is based on responses from approximately 800 farmers. Thankfully, it emphasises that Danish agriculture is coming out of the crisis. Roughly 25 percent of the farmers expect their profits to increase by at least DKK 250.000 this year and by an additional DKK 250.000 in 2012. Only a minority expect a decrease in revenue.

- We absolutely agree with the assessment that the general surplus for Danish agriculture will grow in 2011. Nonetheless, our latest evaluation estimates a fall in incomes in 2012, but that is mostly due to an increasing interest rate, says Klaus Kaiser, Head of Business Economics at the Knowledge Centre for Agriculture.
