"Product prices of meat and skins have increased in recent years and are expected to remain stable at a relatively high level. Productivity gains and the continued low interest rates also contribute to the positive development of the rural economy."

However uncertainty is increasing due to the European crisis.

"This is good progress," says Klaus Kaiser, business manager at the Research Centre.

Farmers operating costs are increasing. The difference in agricultural enterprises operating profits has increased significantly in the past 10 years.

Whilst some producers are struggling, such as the dairy sector, others are seeing good returns and growth.
