



Invitation to the third NorFor Adviser's Workshop in Uppsala the 23-24 of August 2012

Hereby you are invited to participate on the third NorFor Adviser's Workshop in Uppsala, Sweden the 23-24 of August 2012.

This workshop, offer the opportunity to increased experience between advisers in the countries who are using the NorFor feed evaluation system. Such experience would strength our competence about feeding ruminants in general and especially about the NorFor system. This will also contribute to further development of the NorFor system and we can exchange ideas how we can improve feeding advice.

During the workshop we are primarily using English as language (especially in lectures and presentations) but there are several who can translate if you want to comment or ask questions in your own language.

Most of the time during the Workshop will be focused on specific NorFor issues. This year we will discuss a common subject – **Feeding strategy during the lactation** – where we get the chance to discuss feeding strategies in the NorFor countries. Advisors from each country will present how feeding strategies are used in early lactation, mid lactation and late lactation and transition period. It is of special interest how you use different feedstuffs and how you fulfill the basic requirements according to optimization settings and feed ration controls.

Prior to the NorFor workshop there is a Swedish advisor's conference in Uppsala called "Djurhälso & Utfodringskonferensen" arranged by Swedish Dairy Association. If you are interested you are offered to participate on the conference. The conference will be held the 21-22th of August at Uppsala Konsert & Kongress.
