WFD – general regulation vs targeted regulation?

- In Denmark the tradition has been to implement by using a few general measures
- 10 m buffer strips along all water courses
- Catch crops

A much more targeted approach is needed



Missing implementation of project results due to general regulation

- Projects shows that a more targeted approach gives better environmental conditions, improved conditions for production and a number of synergies (climate adaptationm nature, green energy, etc.
- But due to general rules many good ideas are not beeing implemented
 - Multifunctional wetlands, good agricultural practices, etc.

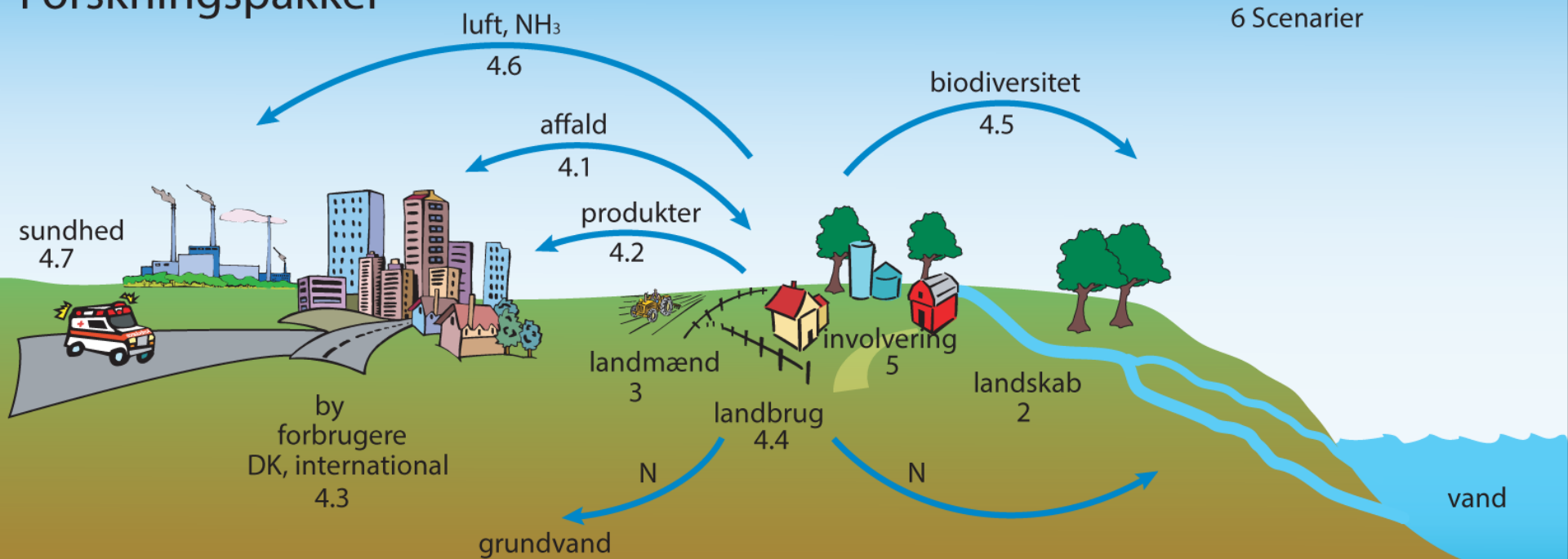
