The water management in Denmark



- A long tradition for general regulation focussing on reduction of Nitrogen load
- From 1985 a number of plans has been made – focus on regulation which are equal for all and made nationally
- Goal: reduction of nitrogen loads by 50% - no focus on the specific water causes





Measures (excamples)



Good farming practices measures like:

- Regulation on how to store manure (9 month)
- Must plough manure into soil within 12 hours
- Reducing the nitrogen norm by 10%, e.g. farmers may now only apply nitrogen in amounts corresponding to 90% of the economically optimal level.
- Catch crops xx pct. of arable land mut be covered by catch crops

Measures at catchment level



 Wetlands – fixed amount of Nreduction capacity (113 kg N pr Ha)

Gives limited room for using the measure for nature, for climate adaptation measure, for handling problem for farmers with more wet areble land in neighbourhood of new wetland

Limited room for other solutions



- No felxibility finding more apropriate measures
- No local engagement in finding win-win solutions
- No ownership to the implementation
- No engangement in finding new ways (reducing the innovative capacity)





Lack of room for finding local win-win WaterCAP Solutions

- Limited knowledge on community-led catchment based approach
- We have just started up a process with water boards (for 3 month) – but the state do it becourse they are forced to do it
