

Knowledge exchange concerning local involvement in water governance (version 5)

Danish visit to Skåne and Halland 4th – 6th September 2019

Background

There have in several years been discussions and initiative for strengthen the local involvement in water governance in both Denmark and Sweden. Water councils have been established in both countries and in 2017 a national program for Catchment Officers (Oplandskonsulenter) was established in Denmark and later in Sweden 20 Pilots with Catchment Officers (åtgärdssamordnare) was established. Even though it could seem similar there are many differences between the programs due to different traditions and differences in governance structures. The driver for the national program for catchment Officers in Denmark has primarily been to implement the National Government goal of establish 900 ha of constructed wetlands within 3-4 years (approx. 1000-1500). In Sweden the primary goal for the new Catchment Officers are to support local measures against eutrophication and take part in the evaluation of how planning of measures can be strengthened as well as what incentives are needed for measures against eutrophication to be performed ("Lokalt engagemang för vatten" / LEVA).

The Danish Catchment Officers have so far been focused on the goal of implementing constructed wetlands with 1 to 1 dialog with the farmers. But there is a much larger not used potential for working with several measures in a cross-sector perspective and in different social structures. Much knowledge and experiences have already been gained in both countries.

With this Danish visit to Sweden the goal is to make cross border and cross project knowledge exchange concerning local involvement in water governance. Projects included in this knowledge exchange are:
