How to reach the city of Łódź

Although Lodz has a local airport (http://lotnisko.lodz.pl/en/index.html), we recommend you to use the connection to the Warsaw Chopin airport (In Polish, also called Warszawa-Okęcie). You can also use the following airports: Warsaw-Modlin and Katowice.

Łodź can be also riched by the international bus (final station name is: Łódź–Fabryczna or Łódz-Kaliska).

From Warsaw Chopin Airport to Lodz

It takes approximately two hours to get to Łódź from the Warsaw- Chopin Airport.

From the Warsaw-Chopin Airport, take the direct train from Warsaw-Chopin to Łódź Fabryczna: Tickets available online: https://mt.rozklad-pkp.pl/en

There are 6 direct trains daily and plenty of indirect ones with only one change at Warsaw-Western (Warszawa Zachodnia) station
